Denis Maire is a public health specialist and a scientist with the World Health Organization Headquarters in Geneva.

Denis is presently responsible for prequalification of all equipment and devices used in immunization services at Headquarters. Denis has been a key player in the development and coordination of guidelines, performance specifications and testing protocols on immunization devices targeting manufacturers.
